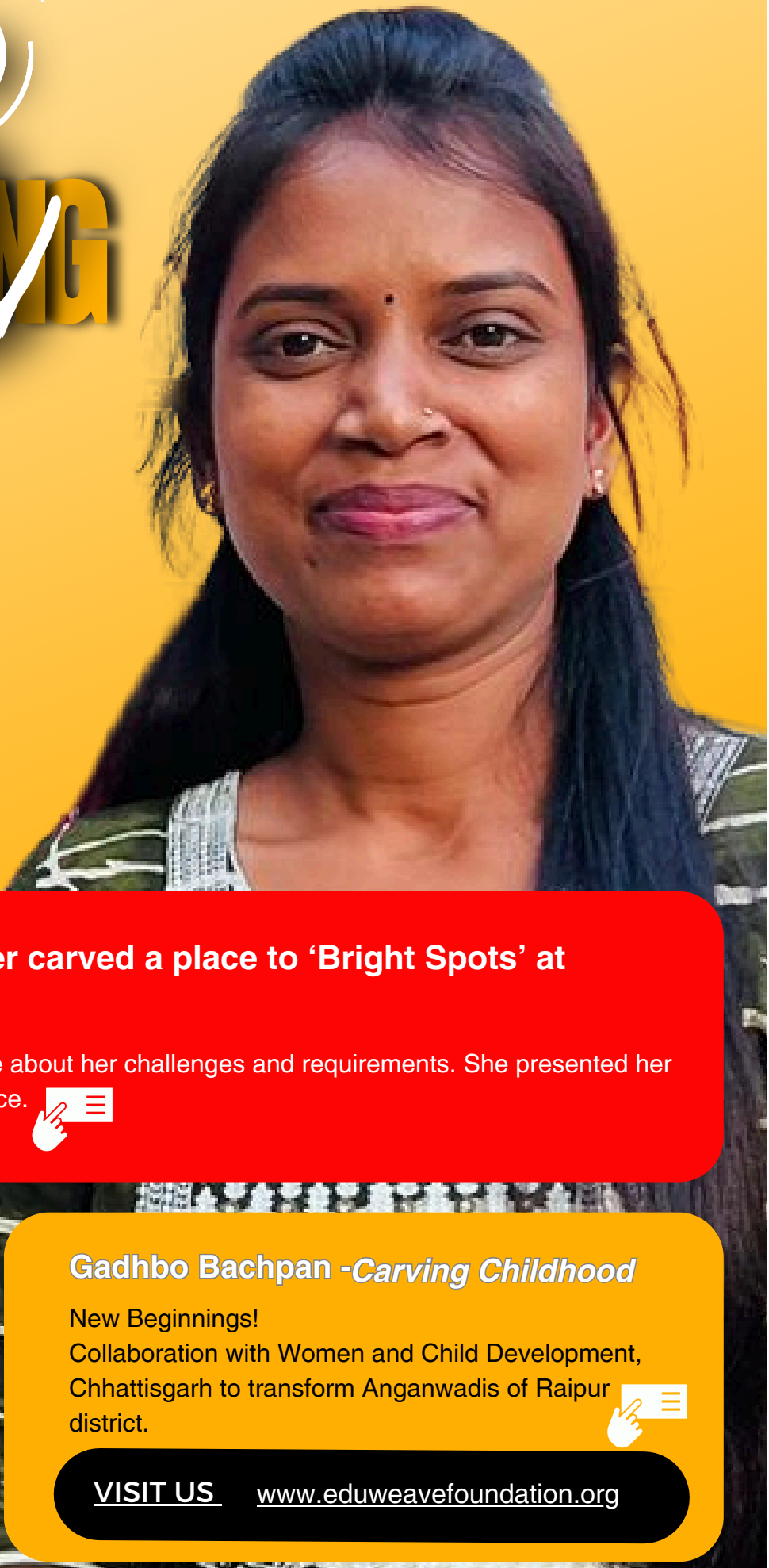

It aims at strengthening of Foundational learning skills through Developmentally Appropriate Practices through micro-improvement process.



Baseline Assessment

Baseline assessment of 200 children was conducted to understand the present level of understanding of children using School Readiness Tool.

Conducted for 66 anganwadis covered in the 1st phase of the project.

66 AWWs trained on curriculum implementation & activities for 0-3yrs.

Reading Enhancement Programme

We participated in the consultation on Content Review & Development for FLN, and facilitated a session on FLN Handbook for Grade 1 & 2. The consultation was conducted in Kashmir and Jammu regions. FLN experts from SCERT and Department of Education participated in the consultation process.

FLN Handbook

As a result of Content Review and Development Consultation in both Jammu and Kashmir divisions, FLN Handbook for Grades 1 & 2 was developed. The Handbook will support around 39000 teachers across the UT.

Shikshāgraha is a people's movement that enables the education leaders, District officials & Civil Society Organisations to lead the co-creation efforts for the need-based programs. The mission is to 'Energise need-based school improvement programs in 100 districts, impacting 40 million children by 2025, collectively!'

In today's diverse classrooms, dialogue among stakeholders is essential. Teachers, students, parents, and policymakers must collaborate to shape an equitable educational ecosystem.

Collective action is a fundamental aspect of Shikshāgraha where people join together in a shared commitment to educational transformation.

From April 2023 to Jan 2024, we visited 30 districts across India and engaged with 55 organisations. We already have 18 Organisations facilitating district programs in phase 1 of Shikshāgraha. EduWeave has started(pls add about your program).
